

Can I Enroll?

Although the 2021 Open Enrollment period has ended, you can enroll in healthcare coverage anytime of year if you qualify for HUSKY Health (Medicaid/Children's Health Insurance Program) OR through a Special Enrollment Period. You must have a Qualifying Life Event for a Special Enrollment Period to enroll.

Qualifying Life Events include:

- Just married
- Pregnancy, birth, adoption, or foster care
- Loss of coverage due to your recent move to CT
- Loss of coverage due to job change
- Divorce or legal separation
- Aging off your parents' plan
- Involuntary loss of coverage

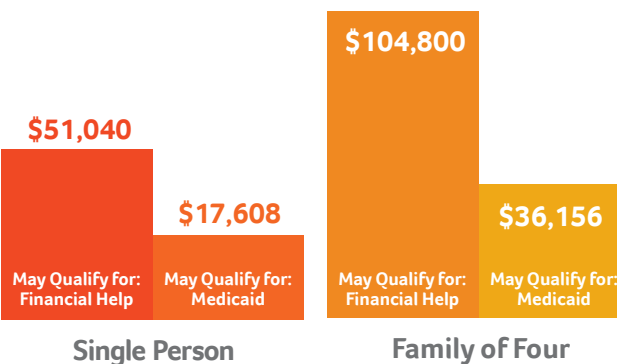

What you need to enroll:

Have this information for yourself, and anyone in your household applying for insurance:

- Dates of Birth
- Social Security numbers
- Visa, green card or immigration documents
- Most recent W2 and/or Form 1040, Form 1099
- Current insurance coverage
- Paystubs, Profit & Loss statements or other employment information to confirm income for everyone in your tax household

Important:

- After you enroll, you may need to provide documents to confirm details in your application, like citizenship and income.
- Contact us during the year to report changes to your account, like income or address.
