Care includes essential medication, laboratory testing; some diagnostic testing and specialty care available. Call to determine eligibility; appointments required; please, no walk-ins. All patients must bring photo ID (official ID required; expired official ID acceptable), proof of income and proof of address, and may require a Medicaid denial letter. Adults ages 18 and older only.

Services are provided by dental hygiene interns supervised by licensed dental hygienists and dentists.

Services include: Dental examination and oral cancer screening; Medical and dental history review; Teeth cleaning (oral prophylaxis); Deep cleaning (scaling and root planing); Dental x-rays; Laser therapy; Oral hygiene instruction; Fluoride treatments and dental sealants; Preventive treatments. Dental x-rays will be forwarded to the patient's dentist upon request.
